Nominations can be submitted by any staff person, volunteer, client or caregiver and must be submitted by **Friday, December 14th**. A Selection Committee made up of ASLM staff will choose the recipient. The award will be presented at Cabin Fever Reliever on February 2, 2019.

Jan was a regular participant in our social recreation programs and believed very strongly in the benefits of social interaction and engaging with the community to make the world a better place.
