

# Henri Toulouse Lautrec

Henri Toulouse Lautrec was born in France on November 24, 1864. He was a French painter, printmaker, draughtsman, caricaturist, and illustrator. He is one of the best-known painters of the post-impressionist period and stands in company with artists such as Vincent Van Gogh and Paul Gauguin.



His work paints a colorful picture of Paris, France in the 19th century, and is portrayed in the 1952 film Moulin Rouge. Over the twenty years, Toulouse-Lautrec spent painting he created 737 canvased paintings and 5,084 drawings. Most of his life and career was plagued with sickness, and he died at the early age of 36 from exhaustion.
